Building a deck? Planting a tree? Installing a mailbox? 811 is the new number you should call before you begin any digging project. As the new, federally-mandated, national "Call Before You Dig" number, 811 was created to help protect you from unintentionally hitting underground utility lines while digging on your property.

For Your Safety

People digging often make risky assumptions about whether or not they should get their utility lines marked due to concerns about project delays, costs and previous calls about other projects. These assumptions can be life threatening. Every digging job requires a call, even small projects like planting trees or shrubs. If you hit an underground utility line while digging, you can harm yourself and those around you, disrupt service to an entire neighborhood and potentially be responsible for fines and repair costs.
