REBATE PROGRAM APPLICATION

Terms and Conditions

- This rebate program is available to Mid-South Synergy Residential Members and applies to New homes serviced by Mid-South Synergy.
- The Rebate applies to Starting October 01, 2010 to December 31, 2010 - (or while funds last)
- Submission of application does not guarantee a rebate, as the funding for the program is limited. Once funds budgeted for the rebate program are exhausted the program stops.
- Members building new homes cannot apply for home improvement rebates. New home owners can only apply for the Touchstone Energy Home rebate.
- The Home Builder must check all the boxes in the application and certify the completion of all the requirements as stated in the application. The builder must also provide the member with a copy of the necessary documents that are required to obtain the rebate.
- Please keep a copy of the receipt, application and any other documentation for your records. Allow 8 to 10 weeks after receipt of all documents to receive the check for the rebate amount.
- Mid-South Synergy reserves the right to verify all projects in order to meet minimum program guidelines. The member may lose the rebate if Mid-South Synergy cannot verify the information provided on the application form.
- After all program requirements are met, a rebate in the form of a check will be issued to the member.
- Mid-South Synergy reserves the right to deny rebates if all the paper work is not submitted or if the form is incomplete.
- Mid-South Synergy reserves the right to make changes to the program without notice.

WALLS

Program requirements:

- **Wall Insulation (Wood)** (Minimum) (R/U) R-16 (2004 leCC = 13/0.82)
- **Mass Wall** R-Value/ U-Value - 4/0.165 (per 2004 leCC)
- **Basement Wall Insulation** R-Value/ U-Value - 0/.360
- **Crawl space Wall** R-Value/ U-Value - 0/.477 (402.2.8 Conditioned Crawl spaces)
- **Knee Walls** - Same as Wall R-Value; Air barrier required.

To receive the rebate: Rebate program application, proof of completed installation in accordance to the above recommended procedures.

DUCT WORK

Program requirements:

- Recommended in conditioned area.
- If supply and return outside of thermal envelope : R-8
- Ducts in floor trusses outside of thermal envelope : R-6
- Building cavities cannot be used as supply ducts. No duct tape.
- Mastic and Mesh or U1-181a aluminium tape required.

To receive the rebate: Rebate program application, proof of completed installation in accordance to the above recommended procedures.

EXHAUST SYSTEMS

Program requirements:

- Outdoor air intakes and exhaust shall have automated gravity dampers that close when system is not operating.
- House wrap N/A

To receive the rebate: Rebate program application, proof of completed installation in accordance to the above recommended procedures.

HEAT PUMP SIZING AND PERFORMANCE

Program Requirements:

- Heat Pump Sizing : Manual J Calc or other approved Heating/Cooling Methods in accordance with section M1401.3 or 2004 lrc. All other Heating/Cooling systems must meet 2004 lecc.
- Air Source : Seer 14, HSPF 8.5
- Ground Source : Closed
- Loop : Cop 3.3 (Heating), Eer 14.1 (Cooling)
- Open Loop : Cop 3.6, Eer 16.2

To receive the rebate: Rebate program application, proof of completed installation in accordance to the above recommended procedures.

ATTIC INSULATION AND VENTILATION

Program requirements:

- Insulation : R-30 minimum
- Vented W/1 Ft2 per 150 Ft2 ceiling area (2004 lecc @ 1 Ft2 per 300 Ft2)
- Conditioned Attics allowed. Insulation is not required to be air impermeable.
- No interior vapor retarders are installed on the ceiling side (attic floor) of the unvented attic assembly.

To receive the rebate: Rebate program application, proof of completed installation in accordance to the above recommended procedures.

FLOOR INSULATION AND GROUND COVER

Program requirements:

- Insulation R-Value / U-Value : R-14
- Ground cover 6-Mil vapor barrier taped at all joints with 6" overlap.
- Concrete slab R-Value : 0.
- Insulation must maintain contact with underside of sub floor.

To receive the rebate: Rebate program application, proof of completed installation in accordance to the above recommended procedures.

WATER HEATER

Program requirements:

- The water heater must be all electric.
- 50 gallon unit = .93 Ef.
- Instantaneous water heaters prohibited

To receive the rebate: Rebate program application, proof of completed installation in accordance to the above specifications by entering information in the fields below.

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DOORS

Program requirements:

- Metal insulated (Exception for entry)
- Performance same as 2004 lecc : Insulated Metal U-.6, Wood U-.5
- Insulation, Nonmetal Edge, Max 45% glazing, any glazing double pane U-.35

To receive the rebate: Rebate program application, proof of completed installation in accordance to the above recommended procedures.

PIPES

Program requirements:

- Circulating hot water pipes R-2 with manual off switch
- Mechanical system piping > 105F or <55F : R-2

To receive the rebate: Rebate program application, proof of completed installation in accordance to the above recommended procedures.

AIR INFILTRATION CONTROL

Program requirements:

- All joints, seams and penetrations
- Site -built windows, doors and skylights
- Openings between window and door assemblies and respective jambs and framing.
- Utility penetrations and other sources of infiltration
- Dropped ceilings or chases adjacent to thermal envelope
- Walls and ceilings separating a garage from conditioned spaces
- Behind tubs and showers on exterior walls; common walls between dwellings; knee walls

To receive the rebate: Rebate program application with name and signature of builder to verify the above mentioned requirements.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Can Lights : Ic-rated; Air tight
- Fenestration U-Factor Maximum : $U=0.55$ SHGC=0.35 (0.75 is 2004 lecc) - Applies to Window/Glass
- Skylight U-Factor : 0.55 (0.75 is 2004 lecc)
- Glazed Fenestration : 0.4 (up to 15 Ft² exempt) Total area not to exceed 18% - waived with performance path - 2004 lecc
